

Cleaning and Degreasing your tank



1. To make the bungs for the tap holes, you can use some corrugated card and some electrical tape.



2. Wrap the tape over the end and around, until you get a good fit.



3. The finished bung.



4. Screw in until it protrudes about 10mm inside the tank.



5. Use the Tank Degreaser to get rid of stale petrol and grease.



6. Shake the tank with the Degreaser for a few minutes and then Drain.



7. Dry out the tank with compressed air or leave to dry in a warm place.



8. Wrap the tank in a polythene bag and seal the end.



9. Seal around the neck with parcel tape, and electrical tape.



10. Screw the bungs into the tap holes.



11. Use the spirit cleaner to remove moisture.



12. Drain the excess spirit out of the tank, and dry with compressed air.
